**Community College of the Air Force (CCAF):** CCAF is an institution of higher learning, with a large stake in the job knowledge and performance of every enlisted person in the United States Air Force. CCAF provides the support for airmen to continue toward other educational pursuits; and provides them with the necessary tools to enter the civilian work force. <http://www.au.af.mil/au/ccaf/> Enlisted members may view their current degree program progress reports or order official transcripts on the AF Portal through the Air Force Virtual Education Center (AFVEC) <https://www.my.af.mil>. The CCAF does not offer college courses. CCAF evaluates and applies credit from Air Force training, civilian college courses, and examination programs. Air Force training certificates may be taken to the Education Services Center to be added to a CCAF record. Civilian college courses and exams may be transferable to a CCAF degree. Enlisted personnel must have their civilian school, or test agency, send an official transcript to CCAF for an evaluation. Evaluation and application of credit takes about 30 - 45 days. **Have transcript sent to:**

**AIR UNIVERSITY ASSOCIATE-TO-BACCALAUREATE COOPERATIVE (AU-ABC) PROGRAM**

The Air University Associate-To-Baccalaureate Cooperative (AU-ABC) Program is an initiative that establishes partnerships between the Air Force and civilian higher education institutions to offer four-year degree opportunities to every Air Force enlisted member. AU-ABC points Airmen with completed Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) associate degrees to a collection of accredited "military friendly" colleges and universities. Students, civilian institutions, and financial aid are linked together via the Web-based Air Force Virtual Education Center (AFVEC). Part of the partnering agreement is that all courses offered by the AU-ABC programs be available via distance learning venues. Air Force students can therefore work toward their bachelor's degrees even as they move to and from locations around the world while serving the nation. <http://www.maxwell.af.mil/au/ccaf/auabc.asp>

**Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University:** Military members may complete a certificate program, in addition to college degrees, utilizing Tuition Assistance benefits. ERAU's Aviation Maintenance Technology Certificate Program is accredited college coursework that prepares individuals for Airframe and Powerplant licensing under the Part 65 format (see faa.gov). Distance Learning courses are available in addition to residential courses. Distance learning courses begin on the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month and are 12 weeks long. Students may pursue residential and online courses with ERAU. Residential courses are 9 weeks long and there are five semesters per year available. 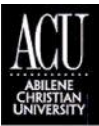

**McMurry University:** McMurry University has been offering courses on Dyess AFB since 1960. It has provided military personnel with resident college classes both on base and on campus. McMurry is a small, liberal arts undergraduate university. On base general education courses are offered in support of the Community College of the Air Force's (CCAF) associate degree through the McMurry ***Blue Streak program***. Courses are also offered on base that may be used in McMurry University's BS degrees in Management, General Business, and Computer Science. Classes are offered in the traditional 16-week semester format as well as in an eight-week minimester format. McMurry University provides an academic scholarship, to active duty military members, who are using Air Force Tuition Assistance. This scholarship added to the Air Force Tuition Assistance covers the total cost of the member's tuition and fees at McMurry University. The member pays only for books. Tuition is discounted for dependents of active duty members.
