SUBJECT: Eligible Customers in Food Service Facilities (S/S Our Memo Dated, 5 Sep 06)

1. This letter establishes policy for who may utilize Dyess Air Force Base dining facility. Feeding policy will be in compliance with AFI 34-239, Food Service Management Program, Atch 9.
2. This listing identifies eligible customers as follows:
  - a. All enlisted personnel
  - b. Officers/DoD Civilians in alert status (fireman, flight line personnel when on duty)
  - c. Dyess DoD Civilians and Officers for a scheduled meeting with Unit Commanders (breakfast only)
  - d. TDY DoD Civilians and Officers for a scheduled meeting (breakfast only)
  - e. Officers and active duty military family members on Federal Holidays, Easter and AF Birthday
  - f. All members on official duty engaged in flight operations as a crew member or as a passenger requiring a flight or snack meal
  - g. Retired military and their immediate family members (spouse and dependent children) (dinner meals, Saturday and Sunday Brunch, and meals on all Federal Holidays, Easter and AF Birthday only)
  - h. On-duty civilian food service contract workers
  - i. Spouses and dependent children of active duty E-1 through E-4
  - j. Members and chaperones of organized nonprofit youth groups
  - k. Dependents of service members deployed in support of overseas operations during special meals
3. Personnel not falling into the above categories will be considered as necessary. Any questions may be referred to Capt Macaluso, 7 FSS/FSV, 6-5527.
