Lieutenant Colonel Nolan R. Corpuz is the Commander, 7th Force Support Squadron, Dyess Air Force Base, Texas. As commander of a squadron with over 400 military and civilian personnel, he is responsible for providing manpower and personnel support, food service, fitness, lodging, force development, recreational activities, Airman and family services, casualty and mortuary affairs support, and installation personnel readiness for Dyess Air Force Base and the surrounding community. He also trains, equips, and deploys Personnel Support for Contingency Operations (PERSCO) and Prime Readiness in Base Services (RIBS) teams in support of combat operations.

Colonel Corpuz was born in Waiialua, Hawaii, and he graduated from Torrejon American High School, Madrid, Spain, in 1990. He earned his commission through the University of Hawaii Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps program in 1994. Colonel Corpuz has held a variety of Headquarters staff and wing-level positions, and he also

deployed to Camp As Sayliyah, Qatar, as US Central Command Forward Headquarters Chief of Protocol. Prior to his current assignment he served as Chief, Military Personnel Programs, Headquarters Air Combat Command, Langley Air Force Base, Virginia.
